

MIKE GROVES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

2025 RULES AND GUIDELINES

Each student's complete application package must be received at the Clarksville Association of Realtors® office by 4:00pm on Friday, March 28, 2025. Supporting documentation to the questionnaire and video/essay may be hand delivered, sent through the mail, or emailed to ypn@clarksvilleaor.com.

- Each application must include a letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, other school administrator, mentor, or an employer that describes the student's character, accomplishments, and why the student should receive the scholarship. Each letter of recommendation must be uploaded in PDF Format along with the referrer's questionnaire found at https://clarksvilleaor.com/ypn-scholarship/ in order for the applicant to be considered.
- Each scholarship awarded will be for **1 semester** of education, beginning with the 2025 Summer semester, and will be subject to available funds at the time of selection.
- Scholarship eligibility is limited to:
 - Those students that will be graduates of a school in Montgomery County, Stewart Country, or Fort Campbell in Spring of 2025;
 - Those students that will attend an accredited 2-year or 4-year college, university, trade school, or the Clarksville Area Real Estate School (CARES);
 - Those students that will begin classes in the Summer or Fall semester of 2025.

- The Clarksville Association of Realtors® Young Professionals Network Mike Groves' Memorial Scholarship will be awarded based on a combination of the following:
 - Personal motivation and initiative as demonstrated through extracurricular activities, community service, work experience and service to family;
 - 2 minute Video submission (preferred) or personal essay (1,000 word limit) that includes what receiving this scholarship
 would mean to you, and how it would impact you, as well as a brief description of yourself and something the decisionmaking committee would not know about you by reading your application.
 - Academic accomplishments as demonstrated through transcripts, scores and recommendations.
- Scholarship recipients agree these photos, their name and their likeness can be used in a number of marketing tools by the Clarksville Association of Realtors® including, but not limited to, press releases, social media postings, and public announcements.
